WHY SHOULD YOU BE INVOLVED WITH SCA 2024 SYMPOSIUM?

The Society of Core Analysts (SCA), founded in 1986, is a chapter-at-large of the Society of Petrophysicists and Well Log Analysts (SPWLA). The SCA symposium is a four-day conference and exhibition, which takes place annually in different locations around the world with 2024 being its 37th year. The symposium features one short course during the first day and a plenary technical session showcasing approximately 40 oral presentations and 60 posters. The annual symposium has built a reputation over the last 30+ years for its high-quality technical presentations in the area of Core Analysis, as well as for giving the main players in the industry the opportunity to showcase their latest technical innovations and offerings in equipment and services. Technical delegates and service companies will be represented and will share their ideas, innovations, knowledge, best practices, products and services.

The associated exhibition will feature approximately 30 stands. Exhibits will be interspersed with the poster session and break area to optimize interaction between exhibitors and delegates. It is anticipated that 200+ delegates will attend this major core analysis conference and exhibition. A social program has also been included, an Opening Reception on the first day, 26th of August, a Young Professionals event the evening of the 27th, a Gala Dinner on the night of the 28th and a field trip on the 30th of August.
